 - i.  - b. New Business:
 - i. **Eastern Toll Road**-no discussion-not present, rescheduled for next meeting.
 - ii. **Peterson AFB 2050 Plan Update**- 21 SW gave a power point presentation on their long range planning for the base infrastructure. Highlights included:
 - a. Proposals to expand Peterson property to the east to facilitate expanding mission growth opportunities in the future and ensure continued force protection and alleviate future encroachment possibilities that could affect mission.
 - b. A new Medical Clinic is also in the 2050 plan, as well as future options for sighting of mission related facilities
 - iii. **Pueblo Army Depot**-Marv Stein, PEDCO Board Member -Mr. Stein spoke about the potential of Pueblo Army Depot being used by Army Material Command for its refit program, currently being done on Ft Carson. Such a move would alleviate the constraints that Ft Carson has for dedicating space for this work.
 - c. Old Business:
 - i. **Cyber Command Update**-Brian Binn –Air Force still in the decision process for the final location of 24th Air Force (Cyber Operations). A campaign to send letters of support to key Air Force officials will be undertaken to reinforce our position that Peterson AFB makes the best mission sense for the Air Force.
 - ii. **AF Global Strike Command:** Final decision by the Air Force is expected early April, with Basrksdale and Offutt AFBs being the lead contender of those being considered. Peterson AFB was not on the list of Air Force bases being considered.
 - iii. **Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC)**- Brian Binn- No decision by the Defense Logistics Agency has been made yet. It still looks very positive that DLA will approve a Colorado

State PTAC. The initial program office for the State PTAC will be in Colorado Springs and be hosted by the Chamber of Commerce
